

PreK-3 Expectations

- Can follow one step and multi step directions
- Use their words to express feelings and problems
- Answer/talk in complete sentences
- Demonstrate flexibility to changes in schedule or routine
- Staying calm when something does not go their way
- Engage in conversation with familiar adults and peers
- Share and take turns
- Respect feelings and belongings of others
- Making transitions between places and people with minimal distress
- Follow rules and routines in classroom and other settings with reminders
- Cooperate in both large and small group activities that are facilitated by adult
- Respect another's attempts to complete tasks independently
- Recognize when someone needs help and offer assistance
- Can separate from parents without being upset
- Proper bathroom behavior
- Independently being able to dress themselves including zippers and buttons/snaps
- Able to sit on the carpet and listen to a story
